This is a call for applications and nominations. You are earnestly invited to consider serving as a volunteer on the Board of Directors. The purpose of the Board is to govern the operation of the Learning Centre.

The Board is comprised of men and women reflecting a broad representation of skills and vocations. Many board members belong to the Masonic fraternity, however you do not need to be a member of the fraternity to participate: indeed, outside representation is desired. You do not need to be a resident of Barrie: in this case geographical diversification is desirable.

The 15 member Board is structured to include Citizen Directors and Masonic Directors.

The Board meets 4 times a year from 7:00 PM to 9:00 PM at 99 Morrow Road, Barrie; 2 or 3 Committee meetings and social functions annually add to the enjoyment of the appointment. It is not a significant amount of time. Your commitment will attract expertise and enthusiasm to our organization. Directors are expected to serve a three-year term and hopefully a second term thereafter.

The Board adheres to a Statement of Corporate Governance and By-Laws; meetings follow Robert's Rules of Order and minutes of the meetings are recorded. The Learning Centre is registered with the Canada Revenue Agency as a non-profit charitable organization, and as such financial statements are audited annually.

The Learning Centre needs men and women to take a leadership position as a Director of this worthwhile endeavour. You are invited to contribute your knowledge, skills and experience.
